What are the POA Office Hours?

- Monday-Thursday 8a-5p, Friday 8a-1p

When do I pay my POA Assessments?

- Coupon books are mailed after property transfer and prior to the first quarter each year
- The assessments are due on a quarterly basis
- Improved \$2,300 annually (\$575/quarter)
- Unimproved \$1,540 annually (\$385.00/quarter)

Who do I contact for a guest pass?

- Obtain your gate code from the POA office
- North Gate 843-757-3001
- South Gate 843-757-3000

How do I retrieve my residential decals?

- Both residential and automatic gate arm decals can be retrieved in the POA office
- Drivers license, registration and insurance are required; automatic gate arm decal is \$5.00

When does the Board of Directors meet?

- The first Tuesday of every month
- Meeting at 6:30, Q&A follows
- All residents are welcome to attend

When do I need Architectural Review Board approval?

- Anything that requires a building permit
- Alters the footprint of the house
- Changes the external appearance of the house
- Painting the exterior (same or new color)
- Modifies the driveway, sidewalk, patio or deck
- The addition of a new structure on the lot
- Landscape projects (major renovations)
- Tree removal

Does Rose Hill charge gate fees?

- Gate fees apply to contractors providing a service to the homeowners to offset the cost of road paving, maintenance and repairs
